## **Sponsor-A-Spot Safety Precautions**

The following safety precautions are to be followed by all individuals and organizations participating in the "Hortensia" Sponsor-A-Spot program.

1. Have a first aid kit available at every clean-up when the project is at an unnamed site.
2. Ensure an adequate supply of water is available during any workday.
3. Participants are encouraged to wear hats, sun block and sunglasses.
4. Participants should always wear gloves and appropriate, good quality footwear. Any open-style footwear will not be permitted.
5. Participants should wear bright or light-colored clothing.
6. Avoid toxic or hazardous substances such as poison ivy, poison oak, areas where herbicides have been placed; animals; and insects. Check with the assigned supervisor.
7. No horseplay during clean-up.
8. No intoxicating beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed.
9. The group leader will review these precautions prior to commencing each and every clean-up and when meeting with the city assigned supervisor.
